## MASONIC WAR VETRAN'S BETH-EL POST #29 SCHOOL YEAR 2023-2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Beth-El Post #29, Masonic War Veterans of the State of New York, a subordinate body of the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons in the State of New York, awards a total of 10 (ten) \$100.00 (One Hundred Dollar) scholarships annually to eligible graduating seniors of schools in Orange and Sullivan Counties (and Ellenville). The following guidelines will be used in awarding these scholarships:

- 1. The applicant must meet at least **one** of the following requirements:
  - A) Be a first or second generation descendant (child or grandchild) of an honorably discharged veteran. Provide veterans name, branch of service, and service dates.
  - B) Be involved/member of a military style organization (JROTC, Civil Air Patrol, New York National Guard Child and Youth Program (NYNGCYP), etc.).
  - C) Have already enlisted (Delayed Enlistment Program) or plan on serving in the U.S. Armed Forces after graduation. Provide details of military plans.
- 2. Be graduating from a school in in Orange or Sullivan County (or Ellenville) in 2024 and be attending college, trade school, or entering military service after graduation.
- 3. The applicant must complete the application found on next two pages, answering all questions and completing the written essay.
- 4. The applicant must provide at least one letter of recommendation (no more than two) from a school or community leader (Principal, Guidance Official, Church, Scouts, civic group, etc.)
- 5. The applicant will submit a 50-100 word hand written essay on "Why veterans are important to me". The essay should reflect on why veterans are important to the applicant. The essay should be handwritten in the space provided on application.
- 6. Each applicant will be judged on the following basis:
  - A. GPA/Academic Standing: Does applicant perform well in school?\*
  - B. Activity: Does applicant have school/community (leadership) involvement?
  - C. Essay Content: How thoroughly was the subject discussed?
  - **D.** <u>Application Appearance</u>: Was the application filled out properly and neatly? Is the essay grammatically correct and easy to read?

<sup>\* -</sup> GPA/Standing only accounts for small portion of scholarship judging. Students with mid or lower level GPA/Standings are strongly encouraged to apply.
